

FACILITIES AT HARTINGTON GROVE QUAKER MEETING HOUSE 2022 – 2023

The Meeting House, with a large adjacent car park, has proved itself an attractive place for small and large groups to meet and has recently been refurbished.

More space and easier access now make it an even more desirable venue.



Seats up to 60 people, with French doors opening to a small garden. Seats can be stacked to provide a large floor space.

The room has video-conferencing facilities available for hire. A cooker, microwave, refrigerator, crockery and cutlery are available in the kitchen which has a serving hatch opening into the room.



A smaller room for one-to-one, small work group or committee meetings.

It can seat 8–10 people and also has a piano: perfect for music lessons.



can seat up to 25 people or 12–15 for craft activities or exercise sessions.

The floor is washable and there is a built-in work surface with sink and running water.

Hot drinks may be made and basic crockery is available.

WILLIAM PENN ROOM

A smaller room for one-to-one, small work group or committee meetings seating 8-10 people



All rooms are on the ground floor allowing wheelchair access throughout and one toilet is adapted for disabled users.

All rooms are centrally heated, extra power points are available, and there is fitted carpeting in all rooms except one.



PRICE DETAILS

Prices vary according to which facilities are used. They are revised annually in September. Cancellation charges may apply.

Morning sessions may begin from 9.00am; evening sessions must end by 9.45pm. 10 minutes are provided around booked times for setting up and clearing away.

Our minimum booking time is one hour, charged *pro rata* down to the quarter-hour thereafter.

£18 for the first hour, £11/hour thereafter

WILLIAM PENN & ELIZABETH FRY ROOMS

£16 for the first hour, £9/hour thereafter

Groups with regular bookings providing tea/coffee and biscuits/cake: £6
